How risky is it?

The value of the fund can go down as well as up. You could lose money.

One way to gauge risk is to look at how much a fund's returns change over time. This is called "volatility".

In general, funds with higher volatility will have returns that change more over time. They typically have a greater chance of losing money and may have a greater chance of higher returns. Funds with lower volatility tend to have returns that change less over time. They typically have lower returns and may have a lower chance of losing money.

Risk rating

TDAM has rated the volatility of this fund as low.

This rating is based on how much the fund's returns have changed from year to year. It doesn't tell you how volatile the fund will be in the future. The rating can change over time. A fund with a low risk rating can still lose money.


How has the fund performed?

This section tells you how Advisor Series securities of the fund performed over the past 6 years. Returns are after expenses have been deducted. These expenses reduce the fund's returns.

Year-by-year returns

This chart shows how Advisor Series securities of the fund performed in each of the past 6 completed calendar years. The fund dropped in value in 2 of the 6 years.

The range of returns and change from year to year can help you assess how risky the fund has been in the past. It does not tell you how the fund will perform in the future.



Best and worst 3-month returns

This table shows the best and worst returns for Advisor Series securities of the fund in a 3-month period over the past 6 years. The best and worst 3-month returns could be higher or lower in the future. Consider how much of a loss you could afford to take in a short period of time.

Average return

As of May 31, 2024, the annual compounded return of Advisor Series securities of the fund was 0.5% since inception. If you had invested \$1,000 in Advisor Series securities of the fund since inception, your investment would now be worth \$1,035.

Who is this fund for?

This fund may be suitable for investors who:

- are investing for the medium to long-term
- · are seeking a regular monthly distribution that may include a return of capital
- are seeking a high level of income
- · are contributing to the income component of a diversified portfolio
- · can handle small changes in the value of their investment

This fund may not be suitable for investors who are looking mainly for capital growth.

A word about tax

In general, you'll have to pay income tax on any money you make on a fund. How much you pay and/or when you pay depends on the tax laws where you live, the type of distributions made by the fund and whether or not you hold the fund in a registered plan such as a Registered Retirement Savings Plan or a Tax-Free Savings Account.

Keep in mind that if you hold your fund in a non-registered account, you must include taxable fund distributions in your taxable income, whether you get them in cash or have them reinvested.

How much does it cost?

The following tables show the fees and expenses you could pay to buy, own and sell Advisor Series securities of the fund. The fees and expenses – including any commissions – can vary among series of a fund and among funds. Higher commissions can influence representatives to recommend one investment over another. Ask about other funds and investments that may be suitable for you at a lower cost.

1 Sales charges

This series of the fund is available to new investors with the front-end load sales charge option only. If you are an existing investor, you may switch or convert to the back-end load, low-load and low-load-2 sales charge options of this series of the fund if the fund securities you are switching or converting from are held in the same sales charge option.

2 Fund expenses

You don't pay these expenses directly. They affect you because they reduce the fund's returns.

As of December 31, 2023, the fund's expenses were 1.47% of its average value. This equals \$14.70 for every \$1,000 invested.

Annual rate (as a % of the fund's value)

Management expense ratio (MER) This is the total of the fund's management fee (which includes the trailing commission), administration fee and any expenses,

Trading expense ratio (TER) These are the fund's trading costs.	0.00%

More about the trailing commission

The trailing commission is an ongoing commission. It is paid for as long as you own the fund. It is for the services and advice that your representative and their firm provide to you. TDAM pays the trailing commission to your representative's firm. It is paid from the fund's management fee and is based on the value of your investment. The rate depends on the sales charge option you choose.

3 Other fees

You may have to pay other fees when you buy, hold, sell or switch securities of the fund.

Short-term trading fee	Up to 2% of the purchase cost of the securities if you redeem them or switch them to another fund within 7 days of purchasing them. This fee goes to the fund.
