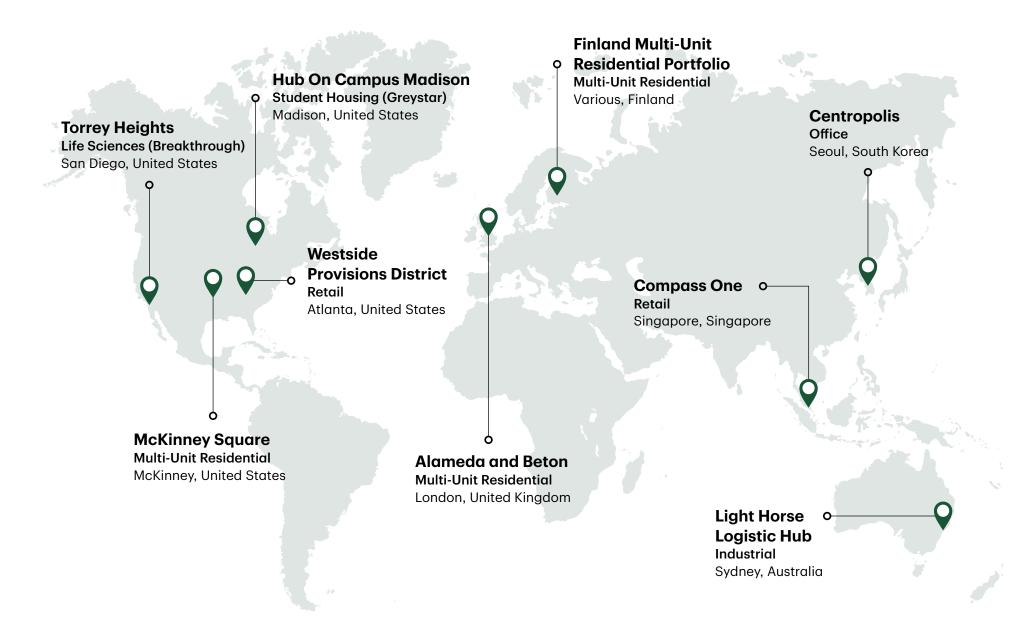

Real Estate exhibits relatively low correlation with traditional asset classes like equities and fixed income, offering investors a hedge against inflation and market volatility. By diversifying across geographies and property types, a global real estate allocation can help mitigate localized risks such as regional economic downturns or policy shifts.

Investors can access global real estate markets through the TD Greystone Global Real Estate Strategy (the Strategy), which offers a core-plus strategy with a mix of direct and indirect assets. Direct exposure provides control and stable income through assets tied to high conviction themes, while indirect exposure offers more

flexible liquidity and broader diversification. Together, they can offer a blend of income generation, capital appreciation, and downside protection. A well-structured global real estate allocation includes a mix of traditional sectors residential, office, industrial, and retail—as well as growing exposure to specialty real estate. Sectors like Life Sciences and Student Housing are increasingly institutionalized and offer durable income underpinned by demographic trends and long-term demand drivers. For example, the Life Sciences sector benefits from increased healthcare spending and biotech innovation, while Student Housing is supported by global higher education trends and constrained supply in key university markets.

By investing across the United States (U.S.), European, and Asia-Pacific (APAC), and blending core, core-plus, and opportunistic strategies, global real estate provides exposure to various markets and property types. This cross-regional, multi-sector exposure not only captures diverse growth dynamics but also enhances the Strategy's 's ability to weather economic fluctuations and capitalize on global macro trends. Ultimately, a global Real Estate allocation can act as a strategic tool for building long-term and income-oriented portfolios.
