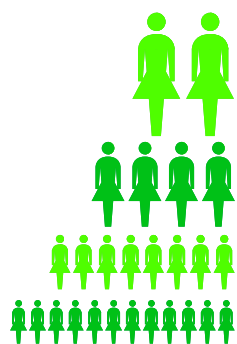




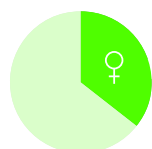

Before joining TD, she was the first female member of cabinet.



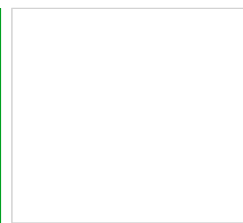
1976

Ed Clark, TD CEO, receives the inaugural Catalyst Canada Honour, awarded to individuals who have made a critical and visible difference to women's advancement.



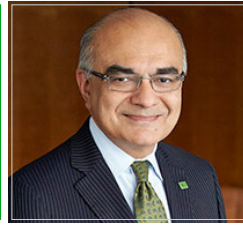
